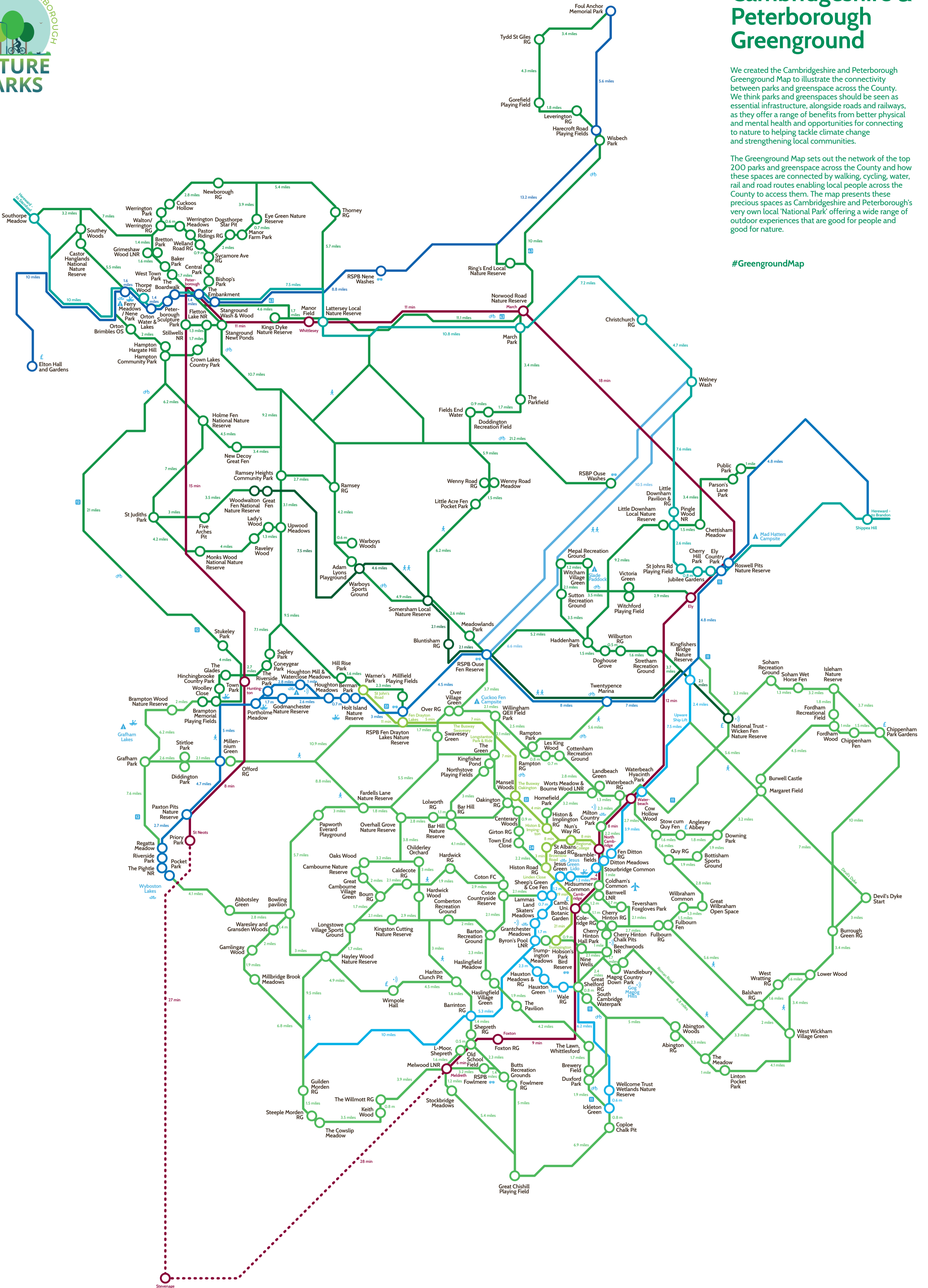


We created the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Greenground Map to illustrate the connectivity between parks and greenspace across the County. We think parks and greenspaces should be seen as essential infrastructure, alongside roads and railways, as they offer a range of benefits from better physical and mental health and opportunities for connecting to nature to helping tackle climate change and strengthening local communities.

The Greenground Map sets out the network of the top 200 parks and greenspace across the County and how these spaces are connected by walking, cycling, water, rail and road routes enabling local people across the County to access them. The map presents these precious spaces as Cambridgeshire and Peterborough's very own local 'National Park' offering a wide range of outdoor experiences that are good for people and good for nature.
